Brief Profile of Mr. Vinay Kumar Tripathi: Shri Vinay Kumar Tripathi (1982 - B.E. – Electrical Engineering) is the **Distinguished Alumnus Awardee of the year 2022 in Excellence in Leadership in the Government Sector**. He retired after serving as Chairman, Railway Board & CEO, Ministry of Railways who is ex-officio Principal Secretary to the Government of India for the Ministry of Railways (from 01-01-2022 to 31-12-2022). Shri Tripathi joined Indian Railways through Indian Railway Service of Electrical Engineers (IRSEE) in 1983 Batch. In his distinguished career, Shri Tripathi has successfully discharged the duties of important post of Electrical Department on Northern, Central & Western Railways as well as held key posts of Divisional Railway Manager, North Central Railway, Allahabad, Chief Electrical Locomotive Engineer, Additional General Manager of Western Railway, Additional Member/Traction in Railway Board and GM/NER.

Shri Tripathi was instrumental in creating many critical infrastructures of IR, e.g. decongesting the rail network of the Division drastically to make it suitable to meet the IR requirements. During his term as GM/NER, the North East Railway transformed from Meter Gauge & Diesel Railway to Broad Gauge & Electrified Railway. The mobility of NER also improved by 100%. NER received First prize of National Energy Conservation Award in transport category and many other awards at U.P. State level. During his tenure as CRB & CEO IR performance all round had a quantum jump as well as large scale introduction of 'VANDE BHARAT' trains took place.

Brief Profile of Mr. Rajeev Kumar Singh: Shri Rajeev Kumar Singh (BE 1992 Metallurgical Engg) is currently serving as the Chief General Manager at Engineers India Ltd, a Public Sector Undertaking under the Ministry of Petroleum & Natural Gas. He has 32 years of extensive experience in project management for large-scale projects in sectors such as Oil & Gas, Fertilizer, Mining, and Metals. He holds a postgraduate degree in Management from BITS Pilani and is currently pursuing a PhD from IIT Delhi.

His Contributions to the IITR fraternity: Led efforts in fundraising for scholarships to support financially needy students from IITR and established a Professor Chair. Conceived and spearheaded various welfare schemes benefiting alumni families.
